Following is a quick reference for contacting Decision Makers in school districts, state regions, in the state government agencies and at the federal level. There are several examples of Pro-Active Music Advocacy letter samples too. PRO-ACTIVE not RE-ACTIVE is the best advocacy!

# <u>LOCAL</u>

This is the Grassroots level...The Beginning of your Advocacy Journey! Start at home with those who are in your school community. Honestly, these are the people who are ultimately responsible for where the support goes in your school and classroom. Be pro-active in making them understand how important music is in the education and lives of the community's students. Remember a community rich in the arts with be a thriving community!

# **REGIONAL**

This level is the next step to support of the arts and music in your region of Kansas. This is the section where state level advocacy begins. You have State Legislators who represent you at this level as well as a state Board of Education member too. Make a point to invite these people to your performances and event to your classroom. They are representatives for your regions to the rest of the state and want to show you are rich in the arts and music!
